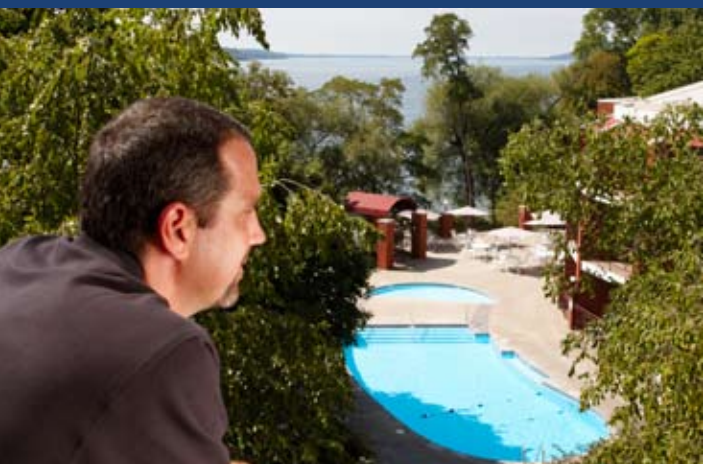

Day 1 - Wednesday

Arrive in the afternoon.
Settle into your room and relax a bit.
